4. Items for sale must be checked in to verify price and condition (verification is required). Jack and Carol will have "check in" at a table located near the interior entrance of the Coral Ballrooms A-C between the hours of 8:00 – 11:00 a.m. on Friday, August 14, 2020.
5. The "best" price for each item to be offered for sale will be indicated on the form and no discount will be made by the Community Table volunteers. If the owner(s) wishes, their name(s) will be given to prospective buyers who may wish to offer a lower price.
